# PRISON PROGRAM IN SLOVENIA

I was in Mayapur on Gaura Purnima. My spiritual master, H.H. Candramauli Swami was also there, and he had just recently published his new book *Holy Jail*. When I received a copy of this book, I immediately started to read it, although I already had with me a half of suitcase of other books. With every page I've read, I became more and more convinced that we should bring Krishna Consciousness to prisons in Slovenia. I stepped into action immediately after arriving home. Actually I didn't know how to tackle the whole thing but Lord Krishna guided me and gave me the right idea at the right moment. I checked when Candramauli Swami was to arrive in Slovenia, and then I asked him for his blessings for arranging a visit to some prison.

In the name of the Rasa society, of which I am a member, I sent an offering to all Slovenia prisons stating that we can perform a public show (artistic performance), the kind we already perform in different institutions (like in schools, homes for elderly people, etc.). I stated that the show will be an artistic performance accompanied with a lecture by H.H. Candramauli Swami.

Of all the prisons I send an offering to, only one prison answered. It was the biggest prison in Slovenia, Communication started with the head of the Education and Reformation Department and I began to assemble a team and a program for the performance. Krishna unexpectedly stepped in a few times and turned my plans upside-down and thus He had driven me almost on the verge of despair.

On May 5th 2010, I drove to the prison with tears in my eyes; I just gave up control and said, "Krishna-You are the Boss!"

The prison personnel greeted us with exceptional warmth and kindness and by doing so they diminished the anxiety we were feeling that was caused by threading on unknown territory. After all the formalities connected with security were complete, we took our places on the stage we had set up in the big dining-hall where 30 prisoners and roughly 10 security men, governesses and other prison personnel had gathered. We started the program with a bhajan in glorification of Lord Nrsimhadeva praying to Him for protection. The leader of our group, Tapta Kancanadi Prabhu was the host for the event. He began by explaining the instruments, used for performance of bhajans.

Then began the lecture, by H.H. Candramauli Swami. He - with his charismatic presentation - had captured the wrapped attention of all the members of the audience. In his lecture he talked about who we really are, what is our relationship with God and how to act in accordance with that relation, He also talked about what freedom really is and also shared some of his experiences he had when visiting different jails in other countries of the world (USA ,India,). After the lecture there was time for questions and answers and then one of the prisoners asked a somewhat provocative question, but Maharaja handled it well, with intelligence, respect and in a calm

manner, so everybody was satisfied with the answer. The musicians then sung Yasomati-Nandana and the Hare Krsna Mahmantra. Before the beginning of Mahamantra, Tapta Kancanadi Prabhu invited everybody to dance and sing along. To our great amazement, all the personnel and the prisoners stood up and danced ecstatically with their hands raised!

"I never thought that I would experience such happiness inside prison!" said an elderly prisoner.

"I have never been so happy in my life!" said one of the members of the prison staff.

And the head of the reformatory compartment said in amazement: "Even the greatest music stars could not get them[the inmates] so animated and fired up, as you did!"

During the December Srila Prabhupada book Marathon there is a special program, called "Shastra Dana". That program consists of an action named "A Matchless Gift". Devotees that cannot participate actively in the distribution of Srila Prabhupada books can finance books that are later on distributed by Tapta Kancanadi Prabhu and the members of his team to the homes of elderly persons, to different hospitals and similar institutions. It so happened that there were some of Srila Prabhupada's books left from December, so we distributed the books (SP Lilamritas and Bhagavad - Gitas) to the inmates and staff.

Many of the inmates gave their book to Candramauli Swami to get it signed. As Maharaja was signing their books, a pleasant communication was going on between Maharaja and the inmates. It was obvious, that the inmates accepted Maharaja as someone they can confide in. Others also joined in and spoke with the inmates. Slovenia is a country with only two million people as it turned out, that there were four inmates, that the different members of our team knew from before: one of the inmates used to supply vegetables to for our temple and he would often give some extra contribution for devotees. Another one had visited our temple and was crying loudly "Haribol, Haribol!!" during



the kirtan. Another is regularly practicing yoga postures and breathing exercises. During our conversations with them we learned, that many of them like to read, practically everybody accepted a book! The inmates have their own choir and theatrical group and different kinds of creative "shops" in which they can express their artistic talents. The activities are led and organized by four ladies, each of them gladly accepted our books, which included two copies of "Holy Jail" and they gladly said that they will use them in their work with the inmates!

By the mercy of Guru, Srila Prabhupada and Sri Pancatattva everything went smoothly and the program was a big success. And although at the beginning we had no idea what to expect. We left there satisfied, waking up more souls to Krishna Consciousness. And in order to keep them awake, Tapta Kancanadi Prabhu already arranged a series of ten lectures entitled "The Wisdom of the East" to be held in the institution in near future. This is a series of ten introductory lectures aimed at acquainting the beginners with the basic concepts and ideas of Krsna consciousness philosophy such as karma and reincarnation. At the conclusion of the before mentioned course is some basics about bhakti-yoga.

As no program is complete without some prasadam distribution, we happily distributed a large number of bananas and oranges to the inmates many of them taking handfuls of Krsna's mercy.

At the end we bid each other farewell and everyone agreed that we must come and visit again.
