Released Inmates

What happens once an inmate who was involved with IPM is freed? Some go on their way and we never hear from them again, or for a while, although we know for a fact that Krsna consciousness has altered their life forever, as confirmed in Bhagavad-Gita 2.40:

"In this endeavor there is no loss or diminution, and a little advancement on this path can protect one from the most dangerous type of fear."

As a proof that Krsna doesn't forget one who performs some service for Him, a few inmates wrote me that they had taken to Krsna while in jail, but gave it up when released. By some unfortunate turn of events, they later went back to jail, where they once again took up hearing and chanting, this time for good.

Some inmates stay in touch even after being released, either, by phone, e-mail or snail-mail. Many engage in practical devotional service like sending a monthly donation, visiting a temple on a weekly basis, giving out books, and even getting initiated.

ISKCON Prison Ministry is a labor of love and a powerful vehicle to spread Srila Prabhupada and Lord Caitanya's compassion to those in need, and the recipients of this mercy are not only eager to get it but also very grateful for any help we can give them.
